2008-2009 School Year*

The assessment was given at the .6 time of the year (February). Thus, the second graders were at 2.6 in the school year, 3<sup>rd</sup> graders at 3.6, etc.

The grade equivalent is a score that describes where the average (50%ile) child in a particular grade scores. For example, our 8<sup>th</sup> graders, as an average score where the average child in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade scores.

This number compares the classes in our school to the classes in other school. Thus, in 6<sup>th</sup> grade, for instance, only 2 % of all schools in the nation scored higher than the 6<sup>th</sup> grade class at Immanuel.
